

DUAL ENROLLMENT UPDATES

Technical Scholarship / Cares Act Funds

Update to Technical Scholarship Funds

- Funds now cover Math courses, Science courses, or CIS 146 for all students.
- Students do not need to be in a technical program.
- 2 course maximum still applies.
- Available Fall and Spring Terms.
- Those currently enrolled in an MTH, CIS 146, BIO or CHM course will be covered automatically, no separate application needed.
- Deadline for NEW students: All enrollment documentation must be submitted to the OneDrive by the high school contact no later than **August 13th**.

Cares Act Funds

Those who apply for Cares Act funds will receive credit for up to 6 credit hours, all courses are covered. Students whose courses are already covered by scholarship dollars may receive a check from the College in mid-September for Cares Act Funds if they complete an application by the deadline.

- Fall Term ONLY
- Deadline for NEW students: All enrollment documentation must be submitted to the OneDrive by the high school contact no later than **August 4th**
- Students who are currently registered for courses will receive the email about the Cares Act application this week. Dual staff will follow up to let students know that they are eligible for these funds.
- *Students* must complete the application to receive Cares Act funds by **August 17th**
- Link to the Cares Act Application will be sent to the students' Coastal email, they must have their A Number to complete the application.

These deadlines are firm to ensure that students can receive funding. No late applications will be accepted.

Dual Enrollment Process:

Students

- Complete an online application
- Turn in their ID and Dual Approval Form to their high school counselor.

High School

Contact/Counselor

- Attaches the student transcripts and testing information (if required) and uploads to the OneDrive.

Dual Staff

- Process applications and registers students for courses

Once a student is processed, they receive their Coastal Student email address.
